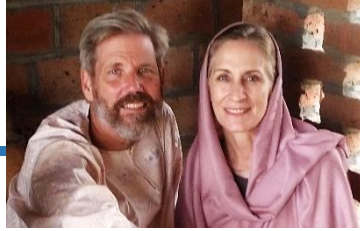

LBIM - Chad



We are in a new chapter of life together as a couple. We have no more children at home. Likewise, after years of formal teaching in a village seminary in Southern Chad, where French was the primary language, we are now running at full speed in the "north"; we're on the edge of the Sahara in a totally Muslim, small Arab village, where most are illiterate, dirt poor cattle raisers and subsistence farmers, and only speak Arabic. But their chief has welcomed us and allowed us to come and build a small training community for missionary family candidates from the south. Please pray that...

- * we will continue to find favor with our chief and the village, for we are dependent on their invitation and hospitality to stay.
- * we will have open doors to develop sincere friendships and plant Gospel seeds in a very tight-knit and closed religious culture.
- * that the Chadian church will make wise decisions in finding couples with a sincere call to mission to the unreached Muslim northerners.
- * these student families will be of quality Christian character in order to
 - 1) overcome inter-tribal prejudices and get along well with each other while in training and contribute positively to our community life together, as well as
 - 2) become good team members after training, when they join our own expat missionaries in some remote region among an unreached Muslim tribe.
