Check-in feature.

- Using the app, you can check off from home or on your drive here, who will be attending Kids' Church or nursery.
- Then you will get a QR code on your phone that you scan on the iPad in the church foyer. This will check everyone in to where they are going. If anyone is going into nursery there will be printed name tags and security code for pick up, all available at the gatekeeper table.
- When children get dismissed for Kids' Church they can go there independently. Nursery aged children must be dropped off and their name sticker put on their back. You will keep the security barcode sticker for picking them up after.
- The person that checks in a child will also be the person who will be printed on the child's label and will be contacted in case of bathroom assistance or an emergency.
