A PILLAR OF PEACE AMIDST PRESSURES

During the night from July 30 to 31, 2024 the banks along the Chilcotin River in British Columbia near Farwell Canyon collapsed causing an enormous landslide. A natural dam resulted that was reported to be 30m high, 600m wide and a kilometer long. In the valley above the dam the river water continued to pour forming an 11km lake. Unknowns about how long the waters would be held back by the mud and debris caused mounting tensions for all downstream knowing the inevitable was imminent. The natural phenomenon created a pressurized situation which would soon rupture.

A week later a breach in the dam caused a torrent of water to surge through the gorge below triggering massive erosion, more landslides and other catastrophic implications. The contours of the river valley were forever changed. Extensive and immeasurable impact included not only the landscape, but people's livelihood and the survival of wildlife such as the salmon that were swimming upriver for their annual spawning ritual.

Consider this colossal event as a parallel to the tensions that have been mounting in your life. What is it that has forcefully impacted your emotional, physical, mental, relational or spiritual well-being? In what facet of your life have you asked the question: "how much longer will I have the strength to withstand the pressures?" Thinking about what a breach in your life could look like is sure to cause overwhelm. Perhaps your personal forecast and fear is that it's imminent.

There is a community of people in the Camrose area who gather regularly in all sorts of contexts to share one another's burdens and offer support as we face life's overwhelming situations. We gather at Resurrection Church seeking ways to navigate the challenges. Together we look to God as our ultimate rescue and pillar of hope. Page through this booklet for ways you too could have a place in the church family, find encouragement, and know the peace of a solid foundation.
