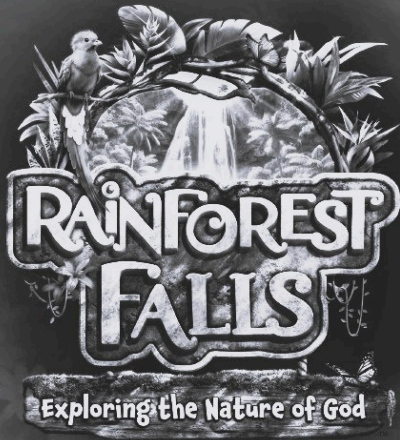
Pray for Our Staff

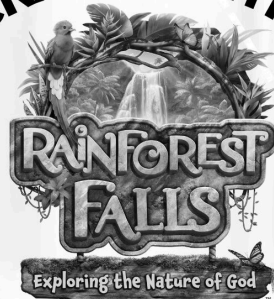
