Hastings Lake Bible Camp

Hastings Lake Bible Camp is a bible camp for all ages and have been running for over 80 years. Director Andrew Carlson and his wife Dieta (office manager) have been with the camp since 2011. The camp right now is getting ready for the summer season by hiring summer staff (cabin leaders, lifeguards, daycamp leaders, kitchen staff etc.) as well as hiring a full time, year round Program Director. Camper registration has also opened for all their summer programing. Upcoming they will be hosting their spring concert fundraiser here at Resurrection on Sunday March 22 at 2:30pm.

Please remember to keep Hastings in your prayers, pray over the camp and their ministry as well as the campers and staff that attend.

The full-time, year-round Program Director is a big prayer request. This person will need to look at camp work as a career in evangelism and long term ministry, as they will not only develop and operate the summer programming, and guide and motivate the seasonal staff, they will create on-going and in-depth discipleship and revival opportunities for children, youth and adults in a camp setting.

Andrew and Dieta would appreciate prayer for their family, and that support in all areas would be provided both in the camp work that they do, but also in the difficulties of staying connected relationally, while juggling 4 children and being a fair drive away from most of their friends.





They've rented a basement suite but would appreciate help to furnish the place so they don't need to move all their belongings.


