ALPHA

Alpha has been going in the COMP this school year since the week after the teachers strike wrapped up and we started at the new Catholic high school since February. At the COMP there has been an average of 20 students a week in attendance and about 10 at St. Carlo Acutis. At the COMP we have been watching one of the alpha series that is geared towards high school students. At St. Carlo Acutis, we've been watching a series called "The Search" which is also geared towards high school students but has a more Catholic emphasis. Both have led to rich discussions about faith and life.

Part of our ministry at both schools is bringing pizza in for the participants and also as a draw to bring in other students. One of the highlights from the year so far, was bringing a box of Bibles given to us by Share Word Global and the students at the COMP taking all the Bibles in the box for their own use or to give to someone else.

We ask that you would join us in prayer for the students who are attending these meetings weekly that they would be drawn into a closer relationship with the Lord and that those who do not yet know Christ would come to know him as Lord and savior. Please also pray for the students who are present in the room but not necessarily for alpha, that they would be drawn into conversations and deeper considerations about faith. And pray for other students in both schools that the Holy Spirit would draw them to Jesus either through this ministry or elsewhere.
