Camrose Neighbor Aid Center has been busy this summer! We are the foodbank, and we also provide free specialty medical rides to Edmonton, emergency help with bill payments, cooking classes to work with the food in our hampers, helping with the breakfast programs in schools and much more!

The number of families needing the foodbank monthly has risen to 400! That is 2000 individuals suffering from food insecurity each month! Unfortunately, along with the increasing need, donations have dropped significantly, causing cutbacks in the amount of food purchased for the food hampers.
