Children's Ministry

NURSERY: AGES 0-3

Childcare is provided during the 11:00AM worship service each Sunday.

Nursery leaders and helpers provide a space for children to engage with books, toys and peer socialization, enabling parents to remain in the sanctuary to participate in Sunday worship.

It is helpful if children are pre-registered in the ChurchCenter App prior to attending.

PARENT ROOM: ALL AGES

Emmaus room (down the north hallway past the offices) The parent room is set up as an alternate location for parents to take their kids during the service if they want to remain with their child, rather than leaving them in the nursery. There are toys and books and the service is available on the TV.

REZ KIDS: AGES 4-12

(PRE-K - GRADE 6)

Sundays 11:15AM-12:00PM (except for Communion Sundays)

Children learn and worship through songs, crafts, videos and more!

SUNDAY SCHOOL AGES 4-12

(PRE-K - GRADE 6)

Sundays 10:00AM-11:00AM

A deep dive into scripture to grow children's faith and knowledge of the Bible.

PRAYER BUDDIES

(CHILDREN AGES 4-12 ADULTS AGE 18+)

One adult and one child are paired together for the purpose of lifting one another up in prayer. Prayer buddies build relationships through connection events on Sunday mornings 3-4 times throughout the year, and in between those connection events they communicate (through parents) the various prayer needs that they have and arrange additional connection opportunities at the parents' discretion.

Special Events

Children are invited to participate in several events throughout the year including: Christmas Concert, Easter Eggstravaganza (April 4) and VBS Summer Day Camp (July).
