## Partner in Ministry and Missions

### Camrose Pregnancy Care Center

The CPCC is currently in the process of becoming a registered Non-Profit Society in the province of Alberta. We are hoping to complete this stage of development by the end of May 2026. At that point we will be looking to hire a woman to serve as our Executive Director (E.D.) on a part-time basis to start. The main focus for the E.D. will be to establish relationships with churches, businesses, community organizations and individuals within Camrose and surrounding areas. Through these new partnerships the E.D. will talk about why and who in Camrose would benefit from a Pregnancy Help Centre and how we plan to accomplish this initiative through prayer and fundraising programs. We believe small donations i.e. \$20.00 monthly to our Centre is a meaningful way to financially support the new Centre.

The Executive Director will also be looking to hire and train women to volunteer in the Camrose Centre as client advocates, we would like to rent office space in Camrose by late 2026 to serve clients who seek help with their unintended pregnancies.

The CPCC has 6 members on our Board of Directors, we are looking to add one more member to the Board.

We certainly would appreciate prayer that God would provide the right person to take on the position of Executive Director. We regard this position as ministry work, this special individual will have to invest her time and efforts with her staff and clients.

Pregnancy Care Canada Centres are Christ focused, we believe offering love, compassion and educational support through biblical principles is the best way to help women in need.
