Job Posting: Worship Coordinator

The Worship Coordinator will work together with the Sunday Worship Advisory Team and pastoral staff of Resurrection to co-ordinate opportunities for the congregation to respond to God through its worship ministry efforts. It is a part-time hourly position, with the average being 16 hrs/wk for 52 weeks of the calendar year. At certain times of the year the position may require more hours and other times will be less intensive.

The optimal candidate will be a gifted worship leader with experience leading and coaching teams. Expectations are to collaborate and provide leadership to all subgroups of the Sunday Worship Advisory Team (ie. worship teams, sound, visual and live-stream techs).
