Consider The Lily is an organization that rescues girls from abuse and exploitation. A core value of ours is teaching the girls of the hope and peace of Jesus Christ and equipping them with eternal hope that is outside of this world. Many of our girls are rescued from their family homes where abuse is happening in the place that was meant to be the safest to them; some are placed here for protective custody, while others have been rescued from being exploited and sold. No matter the background that led them to our family, when they move in, healing immediately begins.

This year's Consider the Lily Summer Camp welcomed over 120 children to learn about the hope of Jesus. Run by the girls who live at the Consider the Lily homes.
