## Reflection Questions on Sermon

After Jesus was crucified, died and was buried He descended into hell (see 1 Peter 3:19).

In Christ's humiliation (crucifixion, death and burial) He came to the fulcrum of the Cosmic Battle with sin, death and the devil.
