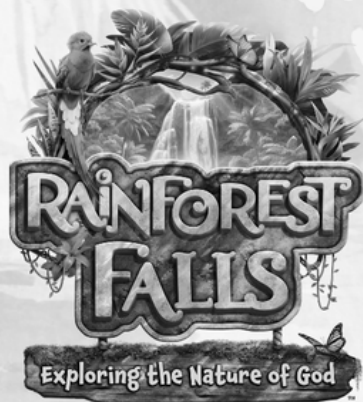

Samaritan's Purse - DART

Samaritan's Purse DART (Disaster Assistance Response Team) serves communities worldwide in the aftermath of natural disasters, conflicts, and medical outbreaks—providing critical medical aid, clean water, and food to those in urgent need. The team is composed of trained specialists who are readily available to respond to complex crises. These experts also equip and lead volunteers, to help with relief efforts while sharing God's love with everyone they serve.

Most recently and locally to Canada, DART has been serving in Manitoba with emergency flooding happening due to excessive rain water. Roads have been washed out, infrastructure damaged and approximately 180 homes effected in Minitonas-Bowsman area where the team is dispatched. Volunteers are on the ground removing debris, drywall, helping with sanitization and cleaning. Praise God no lives were lost, but there is still the emotional toll the residents are facing as they process their losses. Chaplains are available for emotional and spiritual care partnering with local churches.

Prayers are being requested for the residents of the region who are exhausted and grieving. For the volunteers, staff and chaplains to be given wisdom, safety and stamina. That partnership with local leaders and services can be smooth and all can work well together.
